Summary of Minutes of the CAP Meeting of Hong Kong Internet Registration Corporation Limited held on Wednesday 4 December 2013

- 1. <u>New CAP Member</u>: The Chairman welcomed Mr Chan Tze Yee, the new representative from the Office of the Communications Authority, to the meeting.
- 2. <u>Registry-Registrar Model</u>: It was reported that HKIRC had accredited 21 registrars, 7 from Hong Kong and the other 14 from overseas. Performance of external registrars varies, and they have contributed 51% of the total number of new domain name registrations.
- 3. <u>.香港</u>: It was reported that the Company shall carry on with the work to support Hong Kong Supplementary Character Set (HKSCS) and adding HKSCS characters to the Chinese Domain Name Consortium (CDNC) variant table. The work to discover and review variants will be slow and the Company will continue to devote time and resources on this matter.
- 4. <u>Trial IPv6 tunnelling service</u>: The Company reported that with good support from the partners, the Company had launched a trial IPv6 tunnelling service called "goIPv6".
- 5. <u>HKIRC Management Accounts & Statistics January to October 2013</u>: The CAP noted the Management Accounts & Statistics from January to October 2013.
- 6. <u>Changing number of CAP meetings per year from two to one</u>: It was decided that the CAP will continue to have two meetings every year.
- 7. <u>Any Other Business</u>: Dr. Robin Bradbeer gave an update on the 2013 Top 10 .hk Website Competition to CAP members.
